

Road Watch Advisory for the
City of Fort Myers
Wastewater Interconnect Project – Phase II
from South to Central Advanced Wastewater Treatment Plants
Week of October 9, 2017

The City of Fort Myers is installing new sanitary sewer main between the South and Central Advanced Wastewater Treatment Plants. Crews will install the pipes along Raleigh Street to Indian Street, to Palm Avenue, and south to just past Lime Street. This connection will allow more wastewater to flow to the Central plant where the City produces reclaimed water.

- **PALM AVENUE WILL BE CLOSED BETWEEN INDIAN STREET AND LIME STREET beginning at 7 a.m. on Wednesday, October 4 through Wednesday, November 1, 2017.** Motorists may use Dr. Ella Piper Way to Cranford Avenue to Orange Street to bypass the closed intersection. Follow detour signs. Closure will remain in place during daytime and nighttime/overnight hours until work is completed.
- **INDIAN STREET IS CLOSED BETWEEN HIGH STREET AND PALM AVENUE.** Follow detour signs. Closure will remain in place during daytime and nighttime/overnight hours until work is completed.
- **RALEIGH STREET WILL BE CLOSED BETWEEN MICHIGAN AVENUE AND APACHE STREET** Follow detour signs. Closure will remain in place during daytime and nighttime/overnight hours until work is completed.
- Crews continue work on Raleigh Street north of Michigan Avenue. Motorists should use the temporary roadway from the north end of Billie Street east to Raleigh Street as necessary.

Some sidewalks may be closed during the project. Crews are working in and near the roadway. Drivers, pedestrians and bicyclists should use caution and be aware of construction equipment and vehicles entering/exiting streets in the project area. Flaggers will be onsite to assist motorists through the construction zone. The project is expected to be complete in early 2018.
