



## **Road Watch Advisory for the City of Fort Myers**

### **Cleveland Grove Utility Improvement Project September 11, 2019**

The City of Fort Myers is scheduled to replace sanitary sewer and water main, install storm drainage improvements and regrade swales on Turner Street, Patrick Avenue and Kentucky Avenue. The project also includes new sidewalks on the west side of Turner Street, the north side of Patrick Avenue, the east side of Kentucky Avenue and roadway resurfacing.

Construction remains active on Kentucky Avenue and Patrick Avenue.

#### **Kentucky Avenue and Patrick Avenue Alternate Route Available**

- Residential and emergency traffic only will be accommodated along a **temporary access dirt road between 7:30 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.** while work continues.
- Traffic to follow Marion Street to the Shady Oaks Park access road (at Shady Oaks Park) to access the temporary dirt road to Kentucky Avenue.
- Kentucky Avenue and Patrick Avenue intermittent and temporary closures will reopen after 5:00 p.m. each evening to accommodate all traffic.

Crews are working in and near the roadways. Drivers, pedestrians and bicyclists should use caution and be aware of construction equipment and vehicles entering/exiting streets in the project area. Flaggers will be onsite during normal work hours to assist motorists through the construction zone. This schedule may be subject to change due to inclement weather and unforeseen underground conditions. The project is expected to be complete in Spring 2020.
