



Road Watch Advisory for the City of Fort Myers

Wastewater Interconnect Project – Phase III, Part IV Coronado Road September 11, 2019

The City of Fort Myers continues work to replace underground sewer mains connecting to the Central Advanced Wastewater Treatment Plant. Phase III of the project replaces underground sewer pipe along Coronado Road from Cortez Boulevard to US-41; Nelson Street from Coronado Road to Braman Avenue; east on Braman Avenue to Grand Avenue; and north on Grand Avenue to Hanson Street.

Grand Avenue from Hanson Street to Braman Avenue - Flaggers will alternate traffic frequently, but motorists should expect delays.

- Intermittent flagging to take place as needed all day starting at 7:00 a.m.

Coronado Road is intermittantly closed to through traffic from Cortez Boulevard to US 41/Cleveland Avenue. Through traffic to follow detour signs. Local traffic will be accommodated. Motorists can expect delays.

Sunset Road is closed from south of Sunset Place (3022 Sunset Road) to Coronado Road.

- Closure will remain in place during daytime and nighttime/overnight hours until work is completed.
- Through traffic to follow detour signs.
- Residents and businesses may need to access your property from a different direction.

Braman Avenue from US 41/Cleveland Avenue to Grand Avenue – Motorists can expect delays while crews work on the north side of the road and right of way.

Some sidewalks may be closed during the project. Crews are working in and near the roadway. Drivers, pedestrians and bicyclists should use caution and be aware of construction equipment and vehicles entering/exiting streets in the project area. Flaggers will be onsite during normal work hours to assist motorists through the construction zone. This schedule may be subject to change due to inclement weather and unforeseen underground conditions. Phase III of this project is expected to be complete in spring 2020.
