



## **Road Watch Advisory for the City of Fort Myers**

### **Wastewater Interconnect Project – Phase III, Part IV Coronado Road October 16, 2019**

The City of Fort Myers continues work to replace underground sewer mains connecting to the Central Advanced Wastewater Treatment Plant. Phase III of the project replaces underground sewer pipe along Coronado Road from Cortez Boulevard to US-41; Nelson Street from Coronado Road to Braman Avenue; east on Braman Avenue to Grand Avenue; and north on Grand Avenue to Hanson Street.

**Hanson Street/Grand Avenue Intersection Closed** – BEGINNING MONDAY, OCTOBER 21 THROUGH FRIDAY, OCTOBER 25. Closure will remain in place during daytime and nighttime/overnight hours until the work is completed. Through traffic to follow the detour signs. Grand Avenue between Hanson Street and Braman Avenue local traffic only will be accessible from Braman Avenue.

**Coronado Road from Sunset Road to US-41/Cleveland Avenue is intermittantly closed to through traffic.** Through traffic to follow detour signs. Local traffic will be accommodated. Motorists can expect delays.

**Braman Avenue from US-41/Cleveland Avenue to Grand Avenue - Traffic intermittantly reduced to one lane.** – Flaggers will maintain two-way alternating traffic. Motorists should expect delays.

#### **Grand Avenue**

- **From Hanson Street to Braman Avenue - Traffic intermittantly reduced to one lane.** Flaggers will maintain two-way alternating traffic. Motorists should expect delays.
- **Motorists should expect Grand Avenue to be closed at Braman Avenue through Friday, October 25 during daytime operational hours. (excluding Saturday and Sunday).** Local traffic only will be maintained. Through traffic to follow the detour signs.

Some sidewalks may be closed during the project. Crews are working in and near the roadway. Drivers, pedestrians and bicyclists should use caution and be aware of construction equipment and vehicles entering/exiting streets in the project area. Flaggers will be onsite during normal work hours to assist motorists through the construction zone. This

schedule may be subject to change due to inclement weather and unforeseen underground conditions. Phase III of this project is expected to be complete in spring 2020.
