Wastewater Interconnect Project – Phase III, Part IV Coronado Road December 4, 2019 revised

The City of Fort Myers continues work to replace underground sewer mains connecting to the Central Advanced Wastewater Treatment Plant. Phase III of the project replaces underground sewer pipe along Coronado Road from Cortez Boulevard to US-41; Nelson Street from Coronado Road to Braman Avenue; east on Braman Avenue to Grand Aveue; and north on Grand Avenue to Hanson Street.

Beginning Monday, December 9 through Friday, December 13, Braman Avenue from US 41/Cleveland Avenue to Grand Avenue will be closed for storm drain pipe installation.

- Local residential traffic will be maintained.
- Residents may need to access your property from a different direction.
- Through traffic to follow detour signs.
- Closure is expected to remain in place during daytime and nighttime/overnight hours until work is completed.

Grand Avenue from Hanson Street to Braman Avenue closed to through traffic.

- Local traffic only will be maintained.
- Closure will remain in place during daytime and nighttime/overnight hours until work is completed.
- Through traffic to follow detour signs.
- Residents and businesses may need to access your property from a different direction.

Some sidewalks may be closed during the project. Crews are working in and near the roadway. Drivers, pedestrians and bicyclists should use caution and be aware of construction equipment and vehicles entering/exiting streets in the project area. Flaggers will be onsite during normal work hours to assist motorists through the construction zone. This schedule may be subject to change due to inclement weather and unforeseen underground conditions. Phase III of this project is expected to be complete in spring 2020.
