



EMERGENCY BOIL WATER NOTICE

Beginning Immediately
Monday, August 31, 2020

This **EMERGENCY boil water notice** is addressed to and affects the following:

- **1571 & 1574 Cranford Avenue**
- **2608/2610 First Street**
- **2624, 2632, 2643, 2644, 2654, 2674 Providence Street**
- **2673, 2685 Rhode Island**

An emergency boil water notice is effective immediately Monday, August 31, 2020 due to water shut down as part of the City of Fort Myers' Evans Avenue Neighborhood Utility Relocation Project. **You are required to boil your water until a boil water rescission notice is issued (typically 3-5 days).** Water service is expected to be restored by 4 p.m.

You are required to boil your water beginning Monday, August 31, immediately and should continue to boil your water until a boil water rescission notice is issued. We will post the rescission notices after all the samples have passed and are approved.

THEREFORE, AS A PRECAUTION, WE ADVISE THAT ALL WATER USED FOR DRINKING, COOKING, MAKING ICE, BRUSHING TEETH, OR WASHING DISHES BE BOILED. A rolling boil of one minute is sufficient. As an alternative, bottled water may be used.

THIS "EMERGENCY BOIL WATER NOTICE" WILL REMAIN IN EFFECT UNTIL THE WORK IS COMPLETED AND BACTERIOLOGICAL TESTS SHOW THAT THE WATER IS SAFE TO DRINK AT WHICH TIME WE WILL ISSUE A RESCISSION NOTICE.

Wednesday, September 2, 2020 your water will be shut off again and you will remain on a precautionary boil water.
