



WATER SHUT-OFF AND PRECAUTIONARY BOIL WATER NOTICE

Due to Scheduled Water Shut-Off

Wednesday, September 2, 2020 - Beginning 8:00 a.m. through 4:00 p.m.

This **precautionary boil water notice and WATER SHUT-OFF** is addressed to and affects the following:

- **1530, 1531, 1533, 1538, 1541, 1550, 1552 Evans Avenue**
- **2610, 2624, 2632, 2643, 2644, 2654, 2674 Providence Street**
- **2590, 2608, 2610 First Street**
- **2673, 2685 Rhode Island**
- **1615 Avalon Place**
- **1574 Cranford Avenue**

Multiple **WATER SHUT-OFF's** due to construction are required as part of the City of Fort Myers' Evans Avenue Utility Improvements Project.

You are required to boil your water beginning Wednesday, September 2, at 8 a.m. and should continue to boil your water until a boil water rescission notice is issued. We will post the rescission notices after all the samples have passed and are approved.

THEREFORE, YOU SHOULD EXPECT TO BOIL YOUR WATER OR BUY ENOUGH BOTTLED WATER FOR THE WEEK. AS A PRECAUTION, WE ADVISE THAT ALL WATER USED FOR DRINKING, COOKING, MAKING ICE, BRUSHING TEETH, OR WASHING DISHES BE BOILED. A rolling boil of one minute is sufficient. As an alternative, bottled water may be used.

THIS "PRECAUTIONARY BOIL WATER NOTICE" WILL REMAIN IN EFFECT UNTIL THE WORK IS COMPLETED AND A BACTERIOLOGICAL SURVEY SHOWS THAT THE WATER IS SAFE TO DRINK AT WHICH TIME, WE WILL ISSUE A RESCISSION NOTICE. The local fire department and EMS have been notified of this shut off and will closely monitor affected properties and fire suppression systems. **You are responsible to notify your fire protection company, if applicable.**
