



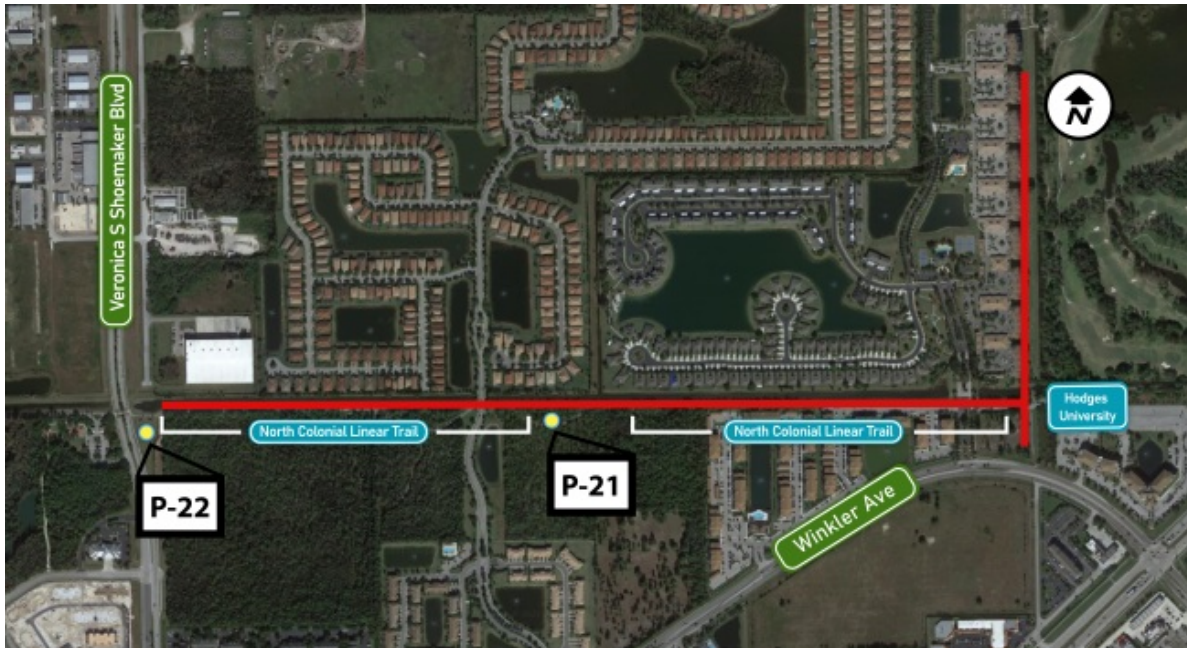

September 15, 2021 Construction Update

The City of Fort Myers is planning for and installing a series of new raw water source wells to supplement the existing City wellfield. In September 2021, the City began construction on wells P-21 and P-22 as shown below.



Current Construction activities will include:

P-22

- The contractor is currently preparing well site P-22 for the drill equipment.
 - Motorists may experience intermittent lane closures and momentary traffic delays in the northbound lane of Veronica S. Shoemaker Boulevard just south of the North Colonial Linear Trail while crews move materials and equipment for the construction activities.
- The drilling contractor is expected to mobilize the week of 9/27/21.

P-21

- The contractor is expected to begin clearing well site P-21 in mid-October.
- Portions of the North Colonial Linear Trail between Veronica S. Shoemaker Boulevard and Hodges University will be closed during the P-21 construction. Additional information will be provided on these closures.
