



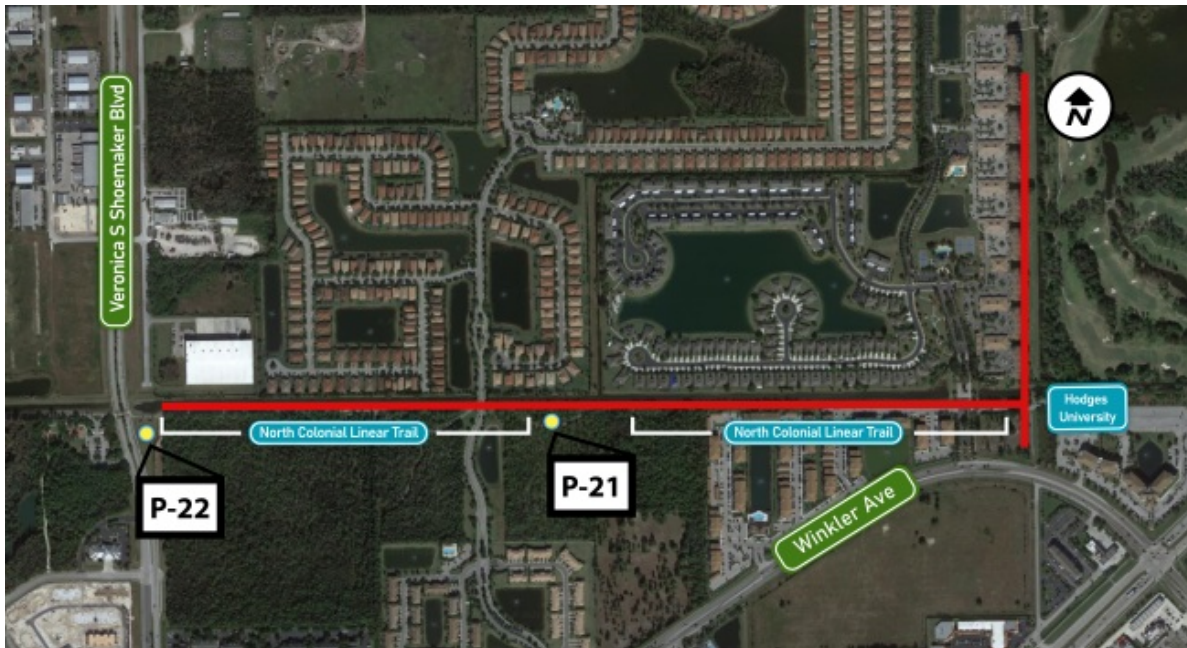
WATER TREATMENT PLANT Source Water Project

October 12, 2021 Construction Update

The City of Fort Myers is planning for and installing a series of new raw water source wells to supplement the existing City wellfield. In September 2021, the City began construction on wells P-21 and P-22 as shown below.



Current Construction activities will include:

P-22

- The drilling contractor is scheduled to mobilize equipment onsite this week.
 - Motorists may experience intermittent lane closures and momentary traffic delays in the northbound lane of Veronica S. Shoemaker Boulevard just south of the North Colonial Linear Trail while crews move materials and equipment for the construction activities.
- Drilling is expected to begin the week of 10/18/21.

P-21

- The contractor is expected to begin clearing well site P-21 late-October.
 - The North Colonial Linear Trail between Alderman's Walk Boulevard and Hodges University will be closed during the P-21 construction. Additional information will be provided on this closure.
