



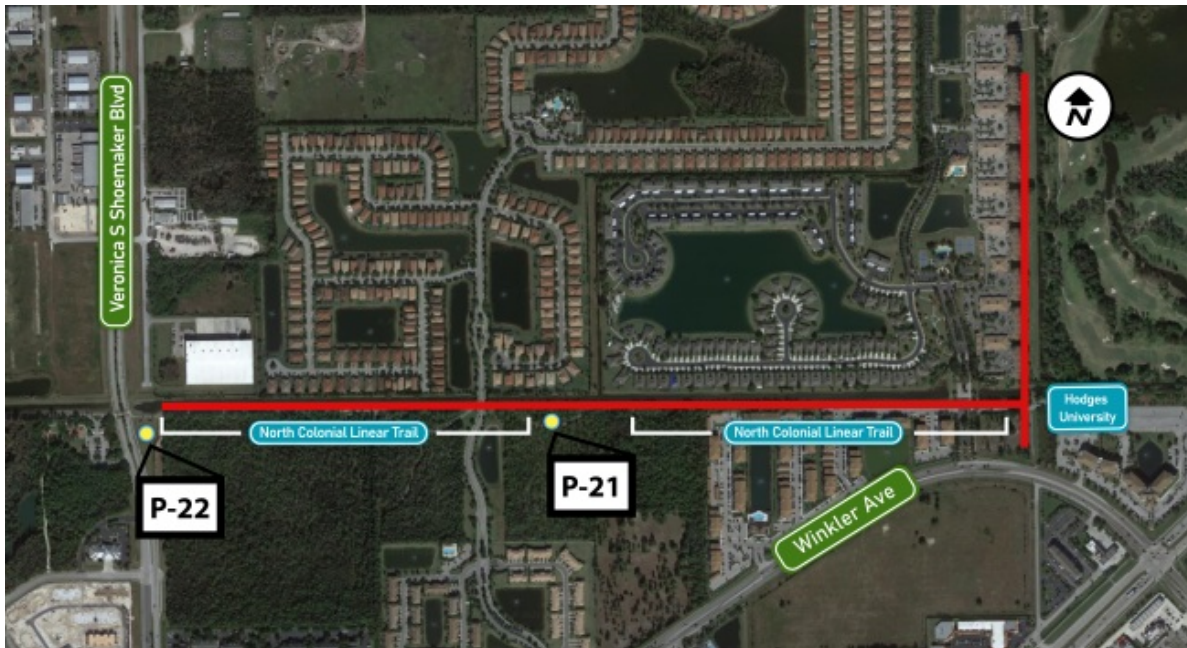

November 5, 2021 Construction Update

The City of Fort Myers is planning for and installing a series of new raw water source wells to supplement the existing City wellfield. In September 2021, the City began construction on wells P-21 and P-22 as shown below.



Current Construction activities include:

P-22

- The well drilling contractor is onsite.
 - Motorists may experience intermittent lane closures and momentary traffic delays in the northbound lane of Veronica S. Shoemaker Boulevard just south of the North Colonial Linear Trail while crews move materials and equipment for the construction activities.

P-21

- The contractor **is expected** to begin clearing well site P-21.
 - **Permits have delayed this work but as soon as the permits are received, they will begin the clearing operation.**
 - **As soon as clearing begins, the North Colonial Linear Trail will close between Alderman's Walk Boulevard and Hodges University** due to P-21 construction. This closure will remain in place until further notice.
