December 29, 2021 Construction Update

The City of Fort Myers is planning for and installing a series of new raw water source wells to supplement the existing City wellfield. In September 2021, the City began construction on wells P-21 and P-22 as shown below.



Current Construction activities include:

P-22

- The well driller is expected to complete drilling the first week in January. Afterward, well testing will take place through mid-January.
- Motorists may experience intermittent lane closures and momentary traffic delays in the northbound lane of Veronica S. Shoemaker Boulevard just south of the North Colonial Linear Trail while crews move materials and equipment for the construction activities.

P-21

- The well drilling continues.
- North Colonial Linear Trail is closed between Veronica S. Shoemaker Boulevard and Hodges University due to the well construction and transmission main pipe installation. This closure will remain in place until further notice. Pedestrians and bicyclists should use extreme caution and should use another route to avoid these construction activities.

Transmission Main Pipe Installation

- Crews are expected to begin the underground pipe installation running east and west from Hodges University to Veronica S. Shoemaker Boulevard.
