



EMERGENCY BOIL WATER NOTICE

Beginning Immediately
Thursday, April 7, 2022

This **EMERGENCY boil water notice** is addressed to and affects the following:

- **Coronado Road (addresses on both sides of the road) from Sunset Road to Cleveland Avenue.**
- **3044 Nelson Street**
- **3052 and 3060/3070 Cleveland Avenue**

An emergency boil water notice is effective immediately Thursday, April 7, 2022, due to a water line break today as part of the City of Fort Myers' Sunset Road, Sunset Place and Nelson Street Utility Replacements and Drainage Rehabilitation Project. **You are required to boil your water until a boil water rescission notice is issued (typically 3-5 days).** Water service is expected to be restored by 2 p.m.

THEREFORE, AS A PRECAUTION, WE ADVISE THAT ALL WATER USED FOR DRINKING, COOKING, MAKING ICE, BRUSHING TEETH, OR WASHING DISHES BE BOILED. A rolling boil of one minute is sufficient. As an alternative, bottled water may be used. THIS "EMERGENCY BOIL WATER NOTICE" WILL REMAIN IN EFFECT UNTIL THE WORK IS COMPLETED AND BACTERIOLOGICAL TESTS SHOW THAT THE WATER IS SAFE TO DRINK AT WHICH TIME WE WILL ISSUE A RESCISSION NOTICE.
