Construction Update

In June 2021, contractors for the City of Fort Myers started construction on the East Water Storage Tank and Pump Station. **Crews are working Monday through Friday and some Saturdays.** The project is expected to be completed in November 2022.

Construction activities include:

General Site

- Maintain the dewatering system

Water Storage Tank

- Tank roof decking and formwork
- Complete decking of the pump vault roof
- Pump vault concrete roof pour
- **Saturday, 4/30 beginning at 12 a.m. nighttime/overnight, crews are scheduled to prepare and pour the final concrete roof section of the storage tank.**
 - This work is necessary to be completed in the early morning hours to avoid material delivery delays and to allow the concrete plant to supply the concrete demand without interruption.
 - Lighting and noise should be expected during this work and is unavoidable.
 - Motorists should prepare for concrete trucks staging in the Treeline Avenue northbound turn lane between Plantation Gardens Drive and Silver Ridge Boulevard.
