



Road Watch Advisory for the City of Fort Myers

Utility Improvements and Reconstruction of Billie Street, High Street and Kunze Street Road watch – November 14, 2022

In December 2021, contractors for the City of Fort Myers started construction on Utility Improvements and Reconstruction of Billie Street, High Street and Kunze Street. The project includes the installation of new sanitary sewer pipes and storm drainage improvements. Crews also will improve and expand stormwater capacity of ponds near the north end of Billie Street. Once the sewer and storm drain systems are installed, roadways will be restored. This project is expected to be completed in fall 2022.

Billie Street – Crews are expected to continue roadway grading and restoration.

- There will be limited access during working hours.
- Motorist may need to access their property from a different direction.

Kunze Street - Crews are expected to continue roadway grading and restoration.

- There will be limited access during working hours.
- Motorist may need to access their property from a different direction.

High Street - Crews are expected to install sewer lines starting at Kunze Street working towards Michigan Street.

- There will be limited access during working hours.
- Motorist may need to access their property from a different direction.

Motorists, pedestrians, and bicyclists should use caution and be aware of construction equipment and vehicles working in the project area and entering Michigan Avenue.
